(1) § 13 Abs. 2 - Abrechnung, Fälligkeit, Vorauszahlung erhält folgende Fassung:



November jedes Jahres Vorauszahlungen in Höhe eines Viertels des Jahresverbrauchs der Jahresabrechnung des Vorjahres zu leisten. ²Fehlt eine solche Vorjahresabrechnung, so setzt der Zweckverband die Höhe der Vorauszahlungen unter Schätzung der Jahresgesamteinleitung fest.
